Agreement

Payment for the session is expected when the signup form is returned. Once class groupings and/or lesson times are planned, refunds will not be granted as agreements have been reached with the instructors. All instruments (excluding piano) will require that you bring your own instrument and that the instrument is in working order. Lessons will occur at LMHS if your student is in grade 6-12 and THES if your student is in grade K-4. It is the parent's responsibility to drop off and pick up their student for the lesson. If a school holiday occurs on the assigned date/time; it is the teacher's responsibility to reschedule that lesson for the week. However, a snow day occurring on the assigned date is the parent's responsibility to notify the teacher and to make up the lesson on a future date. If a student cannot attend a lesson, it is their responsibility to notify the teacher **at least 24 hours** in advance. If student does not show up for a lesson, it is at the teacher's discretion if the lesson will be made up or not.
