

# Band Concert Information Paper

## DON'T LOSE THIS PAPER!! SHOW IT TO YOUR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

The 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade band concert is quickly approaching so here are the things you need to know!

Date of the Concert: Refer to Website for Accurate Dates

**For warm-up/tuning purposes students need to report a half hour before the concert begins**

### **What to bring:**

- Your instrument
- Extra reeds (if your instrument requires them)
- Valve oil (if your instrument requires it)
- Standard of Excellence Books (if it applies to the concert) and all other music that has been handed out

*\*\*Note: You should already be in your concert dress clothes before arriving!! If you need help with ties, etc. that can be done at arrival but preferably done at home. \*\**

### **Here are the rules about concert dress:**

#### Grades 6-8 Concert Dress

In order to appear professional at performances, the following concert attire will be worn. The students have worked very hard to play their music at the highest level so we want to look as professional as we play. We want the music to be the focus of the performance and non-uniform clothing will detract from that. There are no exceptions. If you have a problem obtaining any of the following clothing, please see your music teacher if you have any questions or concerns. Here are the specifics that each student will need to know:

**Girls:** black skirts or pants (no jeans, leggings, or sweatpants), white blouse, dark shoes (no UGG styled boots) and dark socks. All skirts must be below the knee and all shirts must have sleeves.

**Boys:** black pants (no jeans or sweatpants), white collared dress shirt, ties (may be any color but should not light up or make noise!), dark shoes and dark socks.
